

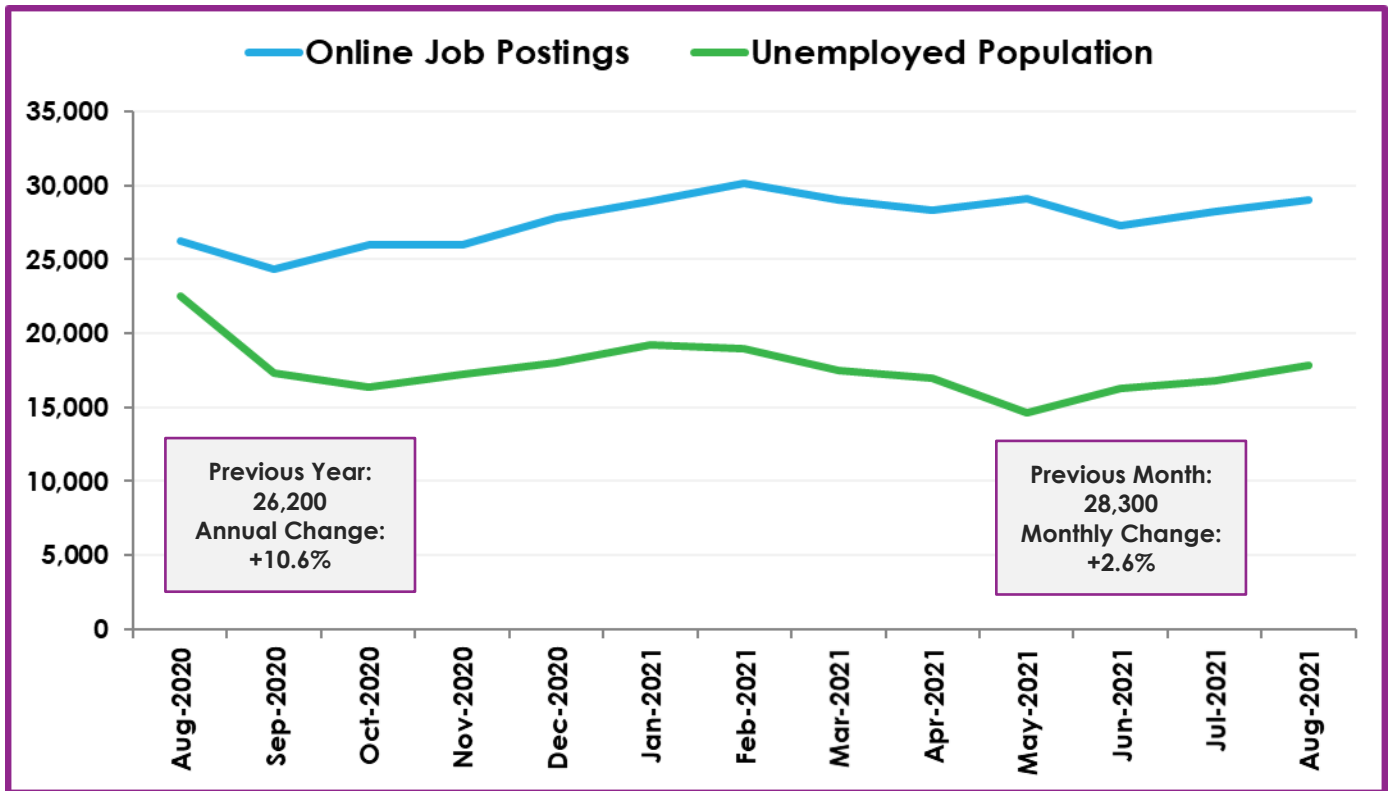
# Online Job Postings Analysis
