



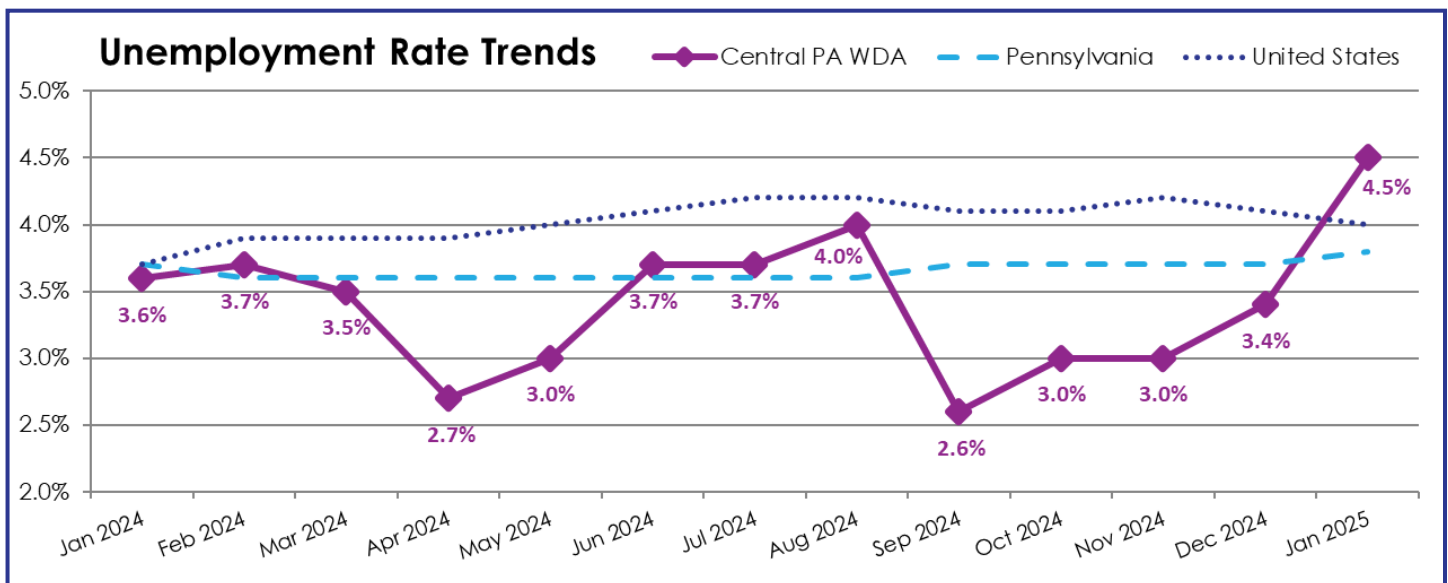
This report provides an overview of the labor market conditions in the Central Workforce Development Area (WDA), which includes Centre, Clinton, Columbia, Lycoming, Mifflin, Montour, Northumberland, Snyder, and Union Counties. In January 2025, the labor force contracted, with employment declining and unemployment rising, leading to a higher unemployment rate than the previous month. **Please note that the labor market data in this report is not seasonally adjusted, and the 2024 historical data has been revised as part of the annual benchmarking process.**
