Central WDA Labor Market Report 🛕 March 2025


This report provides an overview of the labor market conditions in the Central Workforce Development Area (WDA), which includes Centre, Clinton, Columbia, Lycoming, Mifflin, Montour, Northumberland, Snyder, and Union Counties. In March 2025, the labor force increased, driven by increasing employment and decreasing unemployment, leading to a lower unemployment rate than the previous month. Please note that the local area labor market data in this report is not seasonally adjusted, and the 2024 historical data has been revised as part of the annual benchmarking process. State and national labor market data are seasonally adjusted.
