November 2025

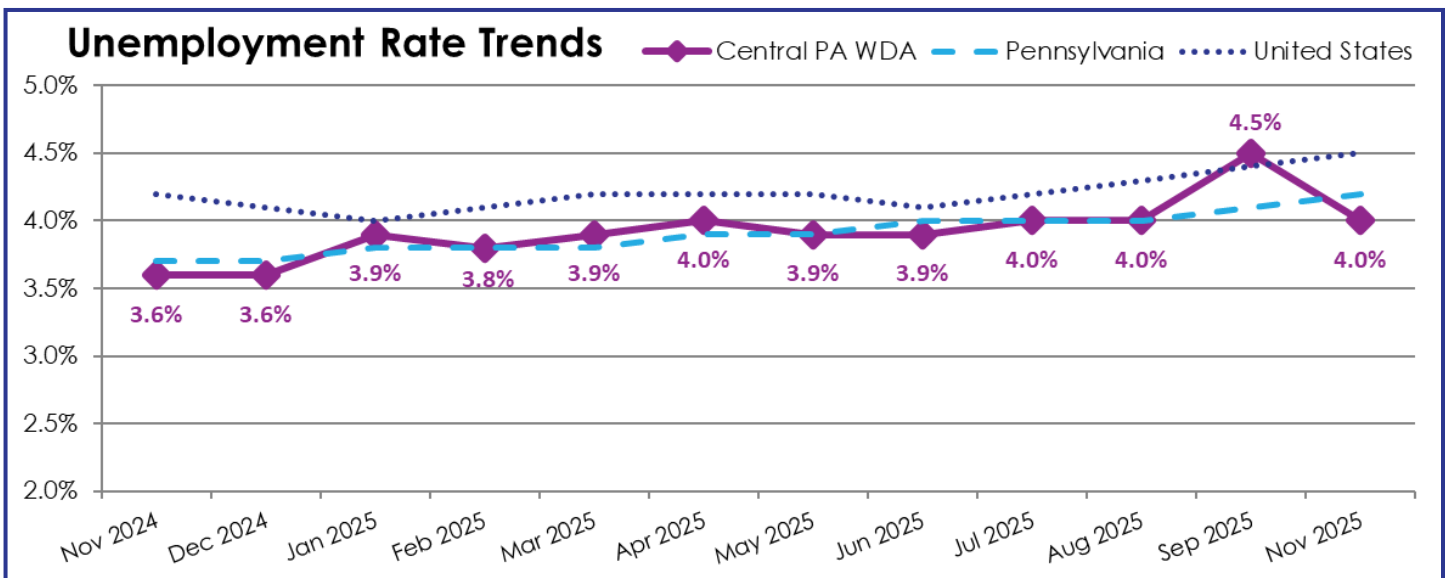
This report provides an overview of the labor market conditions in the Central Workforce Development Area (WDA), which includes Centre, Clinton, Columbia, Lycoming, Mifflin, Montour, Northumberland, Snyder, and Union Counties. In November 2025, the labor force grew driven by increases in the employed population, while the unemployed population decreased, resulting in a lower unemployment rate over the last month.
