



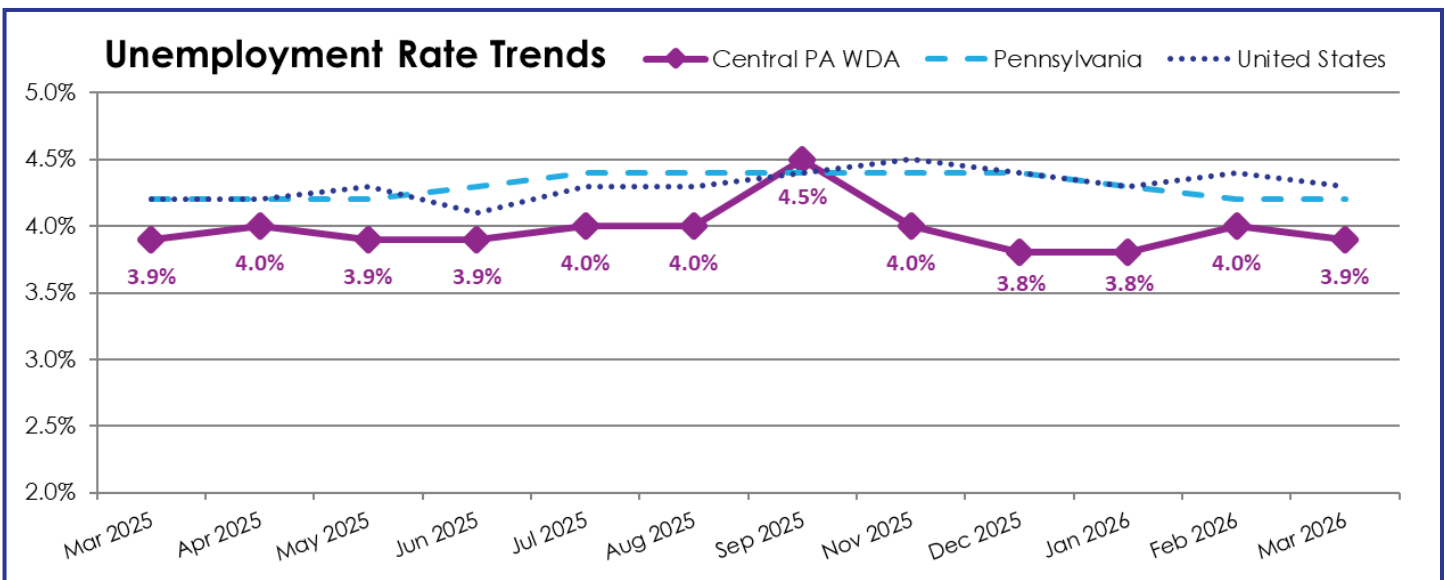
This report provides an overview of the labor market conditions in the Central Workforce Development Area (WDA), which includes Centre, Clinton, Columbia, Lycoming, Mifflin, Montour, Northumberland, Snyder, and Union Counties. In March 2026, the labor force increased due to growth in the employed population, while the unemployed population declined modestly, resulting in a lower unemployment rate over the month.
