



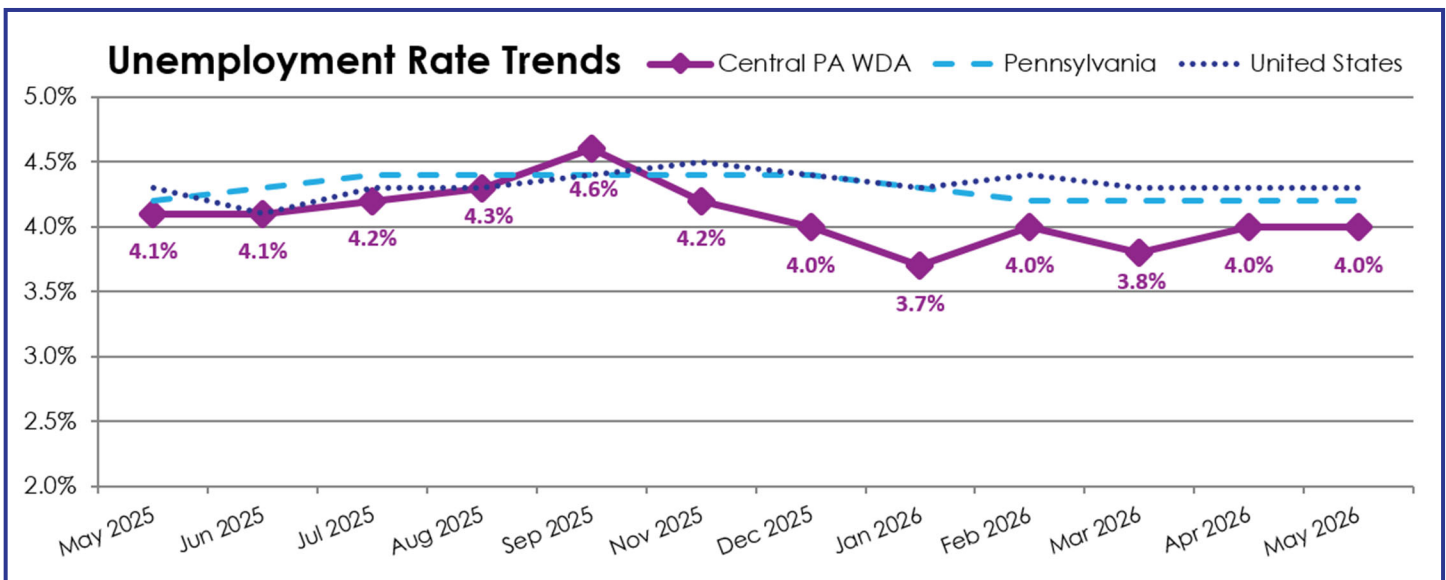
This report provides an overview of the labor market conditions in the Central Workforce Development Area (WDA), which includes Centre, Clinton, Columbia, Lycoming, Mifflin, Montour, Northumberland, Snyder, and Union Counties. In May 2026, the labor force grew as the employed population increased, while a marginal rise in the unemployed population left the unemployment rate unchanged from the previous month.
