



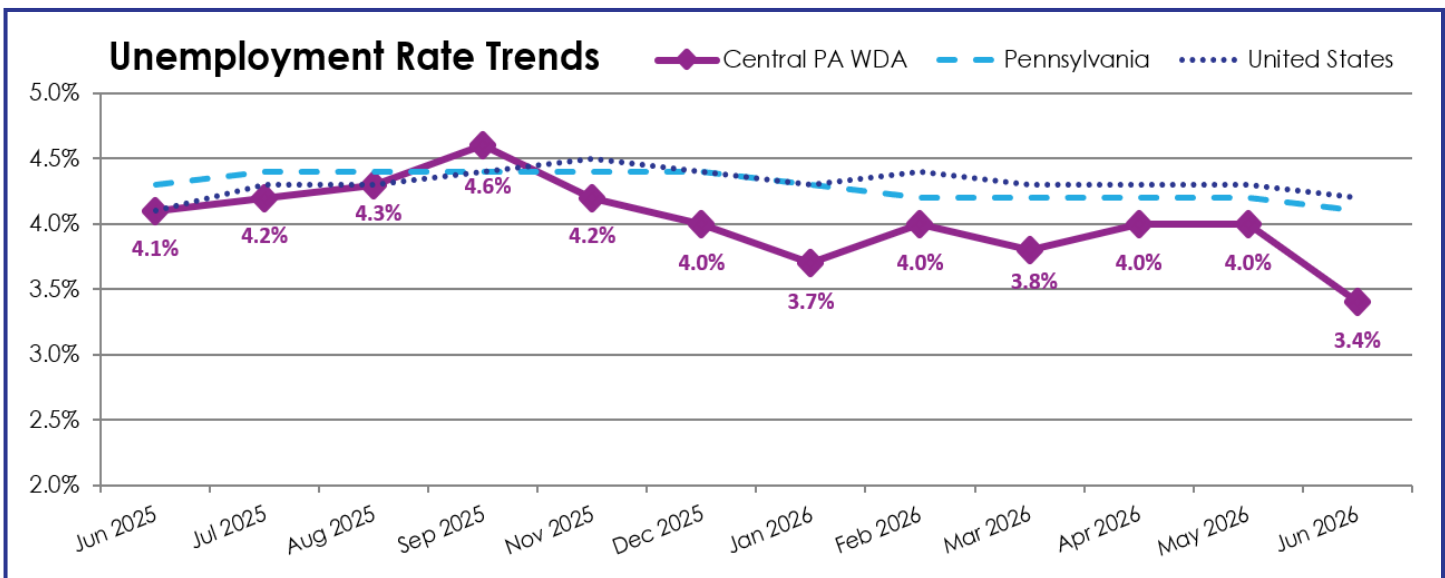
This report provides an overview of the labor market conditions in the Central Workforce Development Area (WDA), which includes Centre, Clinton, Columbia, Lycoming, Mifflin, Montour, Northumberland, Snyder, and Union Counties. In June 2026, the labor force contracted over the month due to a decline in the unemployed population, which was minimally offset by a modest increase in the employed population. As a result, the unemployment rate decreased from the prior month.
